One of only 153 schools with a Phi Beta Kappa chapter and AACSB business school accreditation, Saint Joseph's is home to approximately 4,600 traditional undergraduate day students, 650 College of Professional and Liberal Studies adult undergraduates, and 3,550 graduate and doctoral students. Steeped in the 450-year Jesuit tradition of scholarship and service, the University strives to be recognized as the preeminent Catholic comprehensive university in the Northeast.
