OVERVIEW

Founded by the Society of Jesus in 1851, Saint Joseph's University advances the professional and personal ambitions of men and women by providing a demanding, yet supportive, educational experience. Saint Joseph's has three principal academic colleges – the College of Arts and Sciences, the Erivan K. Haub School of Business and the College of Professional and Liberal Studies/Haub Degree Completion. In total, Saint Joseph's University offers over 55 undergraduate day majors and 50 minors and over 30 degree completion and certificate programs including online options. Graduate programs include over 40 areas of study with many programs offering both campus-based and online delivery options. Special programs include Study Abroad, Honors program, Cooperative Education Program, Summer Scholars, Service-Learning, and Faith-Justice Studies.

ACCREDITATION

Saint Joseph's University is approved by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Education and is accredited by the Middle States Commission on Higher Education.
