Academic Years – 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, and 2017-2018

This report is published in accordance with Act 80 of 2018, the Timothy J. Piazza Anti-hazing Law, 18 Pa.C.S. § 2809 et seq. Act 80 requires the University to maintain a report of all violations of this Policy (or of Federal or State laws related to hazing) that are reported to the University. Violations, for purposes of this Report, means those instances where an individual student(s), a Student Organization(s), or a person associated with a Student Organization was found responsible for violating this Policy (or found guilty of violating Federal or State laws related to hazing and reported to the University). The University will update the report bi-annually on January 1 and August 1 of each year.
