The Minor in **BUSINESS MINOR FOR NON-BUSINESS MAJORS** consists of the following six courses:

- ACC 101** Financial Accounting
- DSS 200** Introduction to Information Systems
- FIN 200** Introduction to Finance *prerequisites: ACC 101; ECN 101; pre-requisite or co-requisite DSS 210*
- MGT 110** Essentials of Organizational Behavior or **MGT 120** Essentials of Management
- DSS 210** Business Statistics *See the footnote below
- MKT 201** Principles of Marketing *pre or co-requisite: ECN 101*

All prerequisite courses must be completed.

*Students who have completed a statistics course in the College of Arts and Sciences that has been approved by the HSB may substitute it for Business Statistics (DSS 210). If this substitution is made, an additional business elective must be taken in order to fulfill the requirements for the minor.
