**Robert T. Healey, Jr.** is an alumnus of St. Joseph's Preparatory School and Saint Joseph's University, where he earned a Bachelor of Science in finance from the Haub School of Business in 2005.

Currently, Mr. Healey is the Executive Co-Chairman of the Viking Group, which manages Viking Yachts, Viking Investments, Viking Associates, Viking Residential and Viking Developers.

Aside from his corporate positions, Mr. Healey's philanthropic activities include Board positions on the International Education Foundation, established in 1998 to support children from low income families to attend Catholic schools and to grow Catholic schools to be self-sustaining; the Gleneayre Equestrian Program, founded to help children and teens who

are experiencing challenges in their lives to overcome these obstacles through a love of horses. He is the Executive Director of the Children's Resource Center, a non-profit community swim club and nature center with a high and low ropes course to build self-esteem in children. He is also the Co-Founder and President of the Healey International Relief Foundation which was established to improve the quality of life of individuals and families in the war-torn Third World country of Sierra Leone in West Africa through medical assistance, food banks for the hungry, health care education, clean water, work programs for amputees and basic essentials for orphaned children so they can reach their full potential.

Mr. Healey also sits on the Advisory Board of the Initiative for Family Business and Entrepreneurship for Saint Joseph's University, and is the Chairman for the Recreational Fishing Alliance, a fishing conservation organization founded to promote the health of fish stocks and protect the rights of fishermen to enjoy the sport. He is a Board member of the Lumberton Economic Development Council, as well as the Lumberton Civic Association, and is an Executive Trustee of the Board of the Northern Palm Beach County Chamber of Commerce. Along with his father, uncle and cousin, Mr. Healey was the recipient of the Greater Philadelphia Area Ernst & Young 2013 Entrepreneur of the Year Award and has also been awarded the Chapel of the Four Chaplains Legion of Honor Award. He is a member of The Union League of Philadelphia, and in his free time, Mr. Healey enjoys participating in Revolutionary War re-enacting as the Chairman of the Continental Line.
