OVERVIEW

Founded by the Society of Jesus in 1851, Saint Joseph's University advances the professional and personal ambitions of men and women by providing a demanding, yet supportive, educational experience. One of only 153 schools with a Phi Beta Kappa chapter and AACSB business school accreditation, Saint Joseph's is home to approximately 4,670 traditional undergraduate day students, 610 College of Professional and Liberal Studies adult undergraduates and Haub Degree Completion students, and 3,580 graduate and doctoral students. Steeped in the 450-year Jesuit tradition of scholarship and service, the University strives to be recognized as the preeminent Catholic comprehensive university in the Northeast.

OFFERINGS

Saint Joseph's University offers over 50 undergraduate day majors and 50 minors, over 16 College of Professional & Liberal Studies degree and certificate programs as well as over 10 business degree and certificate programs offered through the Haub Degree Completion program, over 30 graduate areas of study including 11 online graduate majors, and an Ed.D. in Educational Leadership. Special programs include Study Abroad, Honors program, Summer Scholars, Service-Learning, and Faith-Justice Studies.
