

MOU WITH LOMBARD SCHOOL

SCHEDULE:

MARCH/APRIL = candidates are chosen by the Italian Program

In order to count this internship for credit, we must send additional information to Italy (please contact Dr. Giuli about this)

MAY: students are matched with schools

September: study VISA.

At present we have about 30 Lombard schools and 30 US college involved.

Description of benefits/ responsibilities

Students are “assistenti di lingua straniera”

They are paid 600 euros a month. They are required to work (as lettori/teaching assistants) 12 hours a week.

Lodging: there are three possibilities:

1. they are hosted in a family, who also pays for their food;
2. They are hosted in a family, for small sum (200euros)
3. They rent an apartment; these are small centers, and apartments are cheap (200-300 euros a month, and they can share with another person)

Period depends on students' preference; students are matched with schools that require an assistant over the same period of time.

In order to take courses for college credit, at present students can take courses at universities in Milan, Brescia and surrounding areas.
