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Enhancing Student Learning

There is a proliferation of misinformation pertaining to how students learn and how best to teach. Students themselves often do not fully understand their own cognitive processes, typically relying on implicit assumptions and trial-and-error to learn new material.

The good news is that research provides clear evidence pertaining to what works best with respect to human learning. This session is designed to provide evidence about how humans typically learn, show students and faculty methods to make student learning easier (without reducing rigor), and how all of us can process new information more efficiently.
